

382 Course Requirements

The following represent long-standing absolute requirements for the course; in other words, if you don't meet these, you don't pass.

1. **On time** submission of a camera-ready print copy of your thesis to your supervisor along with an electronic copy either in MS Word or (preferably) html format.
2. Participation in the ISU Undergraduate Research Symposium (oral presentation or poster).
3. The public presentation of your thesis as scheduled followed by an oral defense.

In addition to the above, be advised of the following requirements. Your grade depends on the extent to which your performance measures up to them.

1. **On time** submission of a print copy of your thesis to your mentor.
2. Regular and timely participation in class meetings and web board discussions.
3. Weekly meetings with a faculty mentor or thesis advisor.
4. **On time** posting of assigned drafts to your web space.
5. Posting to our web board timely comments, questions, suggestions, etc. each week in response to others' posted drafts.
6. A professional attitude.

Your final grade for the course will be based on two independent, holistic assessments, your supervisor's and your advisor's. They may take into account opinions of your work from other faculty members and are very likely to when opinions represent pertinent areas of expertise. Supervisor and advisor assessments are *averaged* to determine your grade for the course.
